

Private events on LGIA Beaches

June 2025

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The LGIA Board has decided to institute rules for Association members that request to have private events in order not to inconvenience other members local to the beaches.

If you wish to hold a private event, you must request prior permission from the Board. Julie McNeill will be the contact person for this going forward. The resident cannot book a private event for someone else outside of the resident's family.

1. No political or business events are allowed as per the LGIA Handbook.
2. No more than 10 member guests (not including members themselves) are allowed on either Moore or Battistoni Beaches and room must be made for other residents to use the beach should they wish to do so. Please leave some parking spaces for other members.
3. Children's Beach has been designated as the Beach for members to host a party with more than 10 guests, as this beach is used less frequently, and has more space and parking. A maximum of 30 guests (not including members) is allowed, with a maximum of 6 cars. If necessary, guests can be shuttled to and from your house.
4. The duration of the event should be no longer than 4 hours. And all events must be wrapped up by dusk.
5. Glass is not allowed on the beaches.
6. Please take home with you everything you brought and leave the beach as you found it. This includes all trash - please take home and leave the beach trash can for other users.
7. Please be respectful of other residents using the beach and of local neighbors when playing music.
8. The kayaks and boats/boards belong to residents and are not for general use by guests.
8. No fishing allowed on the beaches as swimmers are often barefoot.
